



## Non-Criminal Parking Infraction Violation

### 1.1 Prohibited Standing or Parking Places – General

No person shall stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or to comply with the provisions of this Resolution or while obeying the directions of a police officer or a traffic control device, in any of the following places:

- A. On a sidewalk, except a bicycle
- B. In front of a public or private driveway or within 2 1/2 feet (30 inches) of such driveways
- C. Within an intersection
- D. Within ten feet of a fire hydrant
- E. On a crosswalk
- F. Within twenty feet of a crosswalk at an intersection or within twenty feet of a crosswalk located within the block where a school is located during regular hours
- G. Within thirty feet of, and upon the approach to, any flashing beacon stop sign or traffic control device
- H. Within fifty feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing  
Within twenty feet of a driveway entrance to any fire station and, on the side of the street opposite the entrance to any fire station, within seventy-five feet of the entrance when it is properly posted with signs
- I. Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when such standing or parking would obstruct traffic
- J. Alongside any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb of a street
- K. Upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a street, or within a street tunnel



- L. At any place where signs prohibit stopping, standing, or parking, or at any place in excess of the maximum time limited by signs
- M. Within one foot of another parked vehicle
- N. Any other locations prohibited as provided for in the Ohio Revised Code
